Instructions for Successful Candidates

- 1. The successful candidates must collect admission forms from the office of the Department of International Relations, University of Dhaka on payment of BDT 60,000/- (sixty thousand only) which includes admission fees of BDT 10,000/- (ten thousand only) and the first installment of tuition fees of BDT 50,000/- (fifty thousand only). The rest of the tuition fees of BDT 40,000/- (Forty thousand only) must be paid in two installments of BDT 20,000/- (twenty thousand only) each before the commencement of classes of 2nd and 3rd semester respectively.
- 2. The admission process must be completed within **11 January 2018** on working days during office hours (10:00 am 5:00 pm).

- 3. Candidates failing to collect admission forms and pay the requisite fees during the stipulated period will forfeit their right for admission and the vacant seats will be offered to the waitlisted candidates.
- 4. Selected candidates will have to follow admission rules and regulations of the University of Dhaka. Candidates who have no registration numbers from the University of Dhaka are advised to collect their 'Migration Certificates' from their respective academic institutions to complete the admission process.
- 5. Any admission related decision of the Coordination Committee would be final. The Committee retains the right to cancel admission of any candidate without showing any reasons.
- 6. Classes will tentatively commence from 21 January 2018.

Instructions for Waitlisted Candidates

- 1. A list of successful candidates from the waiting list will be released on 11 January 2018.
- 2. Candidates having same score in the admission test will be selected based on their previous academic results. If they have similar academic results, candidates will be selected based on their professional experiences and skills. If there is no professional experience, the PMIR Committee will make the admission decision based on overall competence of the candidates.
- 3. Selected candidates from the waiting list must collect admission forms from the Department of International Relations, University of Dhaka on working days during office hours (10:00am 5:00pm) on payment of BDT 60,000/- (sixty thousand only)

which includes admission fees of BDT 10,000/- (ten thousand only) and the first installment of tuition fees of BDT 50,000/- (fifty thousand only) during **14 January 2018** – **18 January 2018**. The rest of the tuition fees of BDT 40,000/- (Forty thousand only) must be paid in two installments of BDT 20,000/- (twenty thousand only) each before the commencement of classes of 2nd and 3rd semester respectively.

- 4. Candidates failing to collect admission forms and pay the requisite fees during the stipulated period will forfeit their right for admission.
- 5. Selected candidates will have to follow admission rules and regulations of the University of Dhaka. Candidates who have no registration numbers from the University of Dhaka are advised to collect their 'Migration Certificates' from their respective academic institutions to complete the admission process.
